Unpacking your Ceiling Bundle

Quick Start Guide

Once your Ceiling Bundle has been installed;

- 1. Switch on the mains power.
- 2. Enjoy the colour changing fibre optics!

Installation details for your Fibre Optic Ceiling Bundle

It is recommended that any wall mounted product is installed by a competent person

Please ensure you select the appropriate fixing for the wall where the product is to be situated.

Wall fixings must be strong and secure to ensure the weight of the product is stabilised.







For brick and breeze block walls Rawl plugs are recommended.

For plasterboard walls suitable hollow wall anchors or plasterboard fixings are recommended.

Experia are not liable for damage or injury caused by poorly installed products.

Installation of the Light Source

- 1. Remove four ceiling tiles in a 2 x 2 configuration of where the fibre optic ceiling is to be fitted.
- 2. Securely fit the light source above the centre of the 2 x 2 ceiling tiles. The light source has 4 mounting key holes. These can be accessed by removing the 2 screws in the cover of the light source and removing the cover. Once the light source is fixed replace the lid and 2 screws.
- 3. Mount the transformer above the ceiling using the 4 mounting locations on the transformer.
- Connect the XLR Power connector to the rear of the light source.
- 5. Connect the mains power into the transformer to a suitable mains socket. It is advisable to have the power switch for the socket accessible from within the room.

Handy tip, when threading the optics as detailed below, have the light source on to aid with locating the holes in the tiles.

- 1. Connect the large silver common end to the opening on the light source, by slackening the securing screw, and inserting the common end. Tighten the securing screw to ensure the optic harness cannot come loose.
- 2. Take 1 ceiling tile and place it in the ceiling grid, mirrored side down.
- Now thread 1 optic through each of the holes in the tile, pulling all the excess optic through the tile. It is good
 practise to separate each optic from the common end, this helps keep the harness in a neat condition and
 helps stop tangles.
- 4. Repeat steps 2 & 3, for each of the remaining tiles. Note, for the last tile you will need to remove an adjacent tile to enable access above. Also note, you will have a few spare optic strands, these can be loosely coiled up and left above the effect. These are in case of any damages during the installation process.
- 5. Lastly, the optics can now be cut to the desired length. We recommend cutting these at various lengths between 5cm to 10cm.
- 6. The installation is now complete, please refer to the operating instruction for use of this product.

Operating Instructions
