Getting Started

- 1. Place the Superactive LED Infinity Tunnel on a flat solid floor or mount securely on a wall.
- 2. Connect the round XLR connector (silver connector) from the Low Voltage transformer to the socket on the side of the unit.



- 3. Connect the standard mains plug to a mains outlet.
- 4. The Infinity Tunnel will now illuminate and will scroll through the many colours.
- 5. Now it's ready to use.
- 6. Insert the batteries into the 8 way controller and you are now ready to interact with the infinity tunnel by pressing any button to change the LED colours.

Cleaning and Maintenance

The unit should be cleaned with a damp soft cloth. A non abrasive cleaning agent may be used for stubborn stains. Ensure no liquid enters the base of the unit.

The unit has been designed for use by people with special needs, however this does NOT mean it is unbreakable. You must ensure the unit is not hit with anything and that no one pulls or pushes the unit.

For best results remove the batteries from the switch controller if it is not being used for a prolonged period.
